For very urgent issues, like a {+1-813-435-6981} compromised account, Coinbase has a dedicated phone line for immediate account lockouts. But be extremely careful. There {+1-813-435-6981} are a lot of scammers who set up fake support phone numbers. Always get the number directly from the official {+1-813-435-6981} Coinbase website. It's a common scam to search for a number on Google, call it, and have someone pretend to be support, {+1-813-435-6981} asking for your private information. Be patient, but also be persistent.
